




Face-to-Face Encounters & Natural Wonders

1. What is included in the price?

- Accomocation in lodges and guest houses with medium comfort (en-suite bathroom and English Breakfast)
- One night in a tented camp in Chobe National Park
- Welcome and farewell dinner, dinner in tented camp and during a farm visit
- All planned drives and transfers, personal tour guide and entry fees.

2. What extra expenses are there?

Travellers will have to pay for a single entry visa into Zimbabwe (\$ 30). There will be no visa fee for Botswana. Apart from the above mentioned exceptions, meals in the evenings or potential snacks at lunch time will have to be paid for by travellers themselves. Booking any of the extra activities "Flight with Angels" or "Gorge Swing" is optional and would come at extra cost.
